

**ANIMAL CARE & CONTROL OF NYC CELEBRATES ADOPT-A-CAT MONTH**

***June means summer, sun, and reduced adoption fees for felines!***

**New York, June 4, 2014** – Animal Care & Control of NYC (AC&C) is celebrating Adopt-a-Cat Month with several specials to purr about! This June, animal lovers have multiple opportunities to bring home a fabulous feline for a reduced or waived adoption fee:

- **Whiskers for Wednesdays** – every Wednesday in June, the adoption fee for all adult cats will be \$5 (usually \$25-\$50).
- **Black (and Torbie!) Cat Appreciation Day** – on Friday, June 13, all black or mostly black cats will be available for a \$5 adoption fee (adults) or \$20 (kittens).
- **Summer Lovin’ weekend adoption specials** – on June 21-22 and June 28-29, the adoption fee for adult cats will be \$5, and for kittens \$20. The special extends to other species as well, with a \$40 adoption fee for adult dogs, \$75 for puppies, and \$35 for rabbits.
- **Cat of the Day promotion**– AC&C is spotlighting a different cat on [Facebook](#) each day in June, and the adoption fees for featured felines will be waived the day their profiles are posted.
