


DANDIES TO THE RESCUE COMING THIS SATURDAY

AC&C adoptions include vaccinations, a microchip, spay/neuter, a free office visit at a participating veterinarian and a free identification tag. AC&C’s Mobile Adoption Center travels the city with adorable dogs and cats up for adoption, and upcoming stops include Adoptapalooza in Union Square on Sunday, September 7 (12-5pm) and an event with Manhattan Veterinary Group (2nd Ave. and E. 80th) on Saturday, September 20 (12-4pm).

Adopters can always meet great animals available for adoption daily at AC&C’s three Care
